## **Key Tasks and Responsibilities**

- Contribution to the analysis of anomalies technical root cause raised by the Operator/Service Provider or Industry System Prime and contribute to the relevant anomaly review processes and boards (e.g. ORB, ARB, NRB, SYS-NCB) addressing UNCLA and CLA issues;
- Contribution to the specification of the mitigation actions for those SW components impacted by software obsolescence issues and/or obsolescence risk;
- Contribute to the specification of the mitigation actions for those SW components impacted by security vulnerabilities;
- Support to the interface with Operator/Service Provider to identify operability and maintainability improvements to be injected in future maintenance releases;
- Contribution to the content definition for each maintenance release in terms of nonconformance correction, hardware & software obsolescence resolution, operability & maintainability improvements, security vulnerabilities, operations baseline evolutions (evolutive maintenance/minor releases)
- Contribution to the evaluation of SW patches necessary to correct e.g. anomalies of vulnerabilities as proposed by the operators in order to confirm that the qualification boundary of the system in operations is not affected (i.e. that the SW patches can be actually categorized as maintenance releases
